### **PCI198: Perfection of Prayer [Online]**

**Shaykh Musa Sugapong**

*Sundays, 6pm to 7:15pm [January 17 to April 11]*

Allah the Exalted says in the Qur'an, "Indeed the believers have succeeded." Thereafter he describes the traits of the believers by first mentioning, "[They are] those who have devotion in their prayers."

Devotion is a central aspect of the prayer as it deals with one's heart. However, before one can master the inner dimensions of the prayer they must first be competent with regards to its outer dimensions. It is our outward motions and appearance which serve as a vehicle for the acceptance of the inward. Being oblivious to the elemental parts of the prayer will prevent a devoted heart from ever reaching its aim.

This course will acquaint the student with the integral aspects of the prayer, ensuring that the prayer is performed correctly, while also focusing on the inner dimensions of the prayer in order to couple the outward soundness with inward devotion.

### **ISE101: Islamic Essentials, The Universality of Islam [Online]**

Among the challenges many Muslims face is a fragile understanding of the foundational principles of Islam, the reality of Allah's existence and the truth of the Prophet (s).

This program will cover these issues while clarifying the principles of Islam in an engaging way. ## PCA101: Arabic 101 with Arabic Lab

*Saturdays, 10am to 12pm [January 16 to April 17]*

This course introduces students to Arabic morphology (şarf) and Arabic syntax (naḥw) concurrently. Students will additionally be exposed to the application of Arabic grammar through literature reading and comprehension.

**Morphology:** Students will potentially learn all the categories of regular verb forms (*mujarrad*). In one semester, through the study of morphology students will be able to derive over 70 meanings of any regular verb which will be multiplied each semester.

**Syntax:** Students will be introduced to the essentials of Arabic syntax through the instructor's lectures. The course aids the students in understanding and applying all the core Arabic grammar rules through textual study and supplementary exercise questions. By the end of the course, students will have the introductory knowledge of the science of syntax and will be able to identify declinable (*mu'rab*) and indeclinable (*mabni*) words while also gaining a general knowledge of grammatical states of words in the Arabic language.

## QUR101: Art of Qur'an Recitation, *al-Muqaddamah al-Jazarariyyah*

*Wednesdays, 8pm to 9pm [January 13 to April 14]*

The course consists of an in-depth study of *al-Muqaddamah al-Jazarariyyah* of Imam Ibn al-Jazarī (d. 833/1430), which introduces students to the philosophy and norms of *tajwīd* (rules of recitation of the Qur'ān). This course also explores the different opinions on certain rules of *tajwīd*. Imām Ibn al-Jazarī's work is one that is studied worldwide and is considered a must-study text for any serious student of the Qur'ān.

*Pre-approval from the instructor will be required for acceptance in this course.*
